Did you know that 2010 is a Census year? Census questionnaires will be mailed or delivered to every household in the United States in March 2010. Make sure to take the time to fill out your Census questionnaire accurately and completely – it takes less than 10 minutes! Census data are used to distribute Congressional seats to states, to make decisions about what community services to provide, and to distribute \$400 billion in federal funds to local, state and tribal governments each year.
