Arts in the Park Summer Workshops continues to be a vital component of the SRAC's annual programming with a focus on the mission to transform lives and enrich our community through the arts.

In 2002, Arts in the Park Summer Workshops began with support from the Community Foundation of the Ozarks to fulfill two purposes within the newly renovated Creamery Arts Center: to start a summer program that would instill cultural and academic confidence as well as a lifetime appreciation for the arts in area at-risk youth, and to utilize and provide monetary support for local arts organizations and local teaching artists.

The program began with 40 students in 2002 and is now serving 70 students weekly, grades K-8. Students are bussed to The Creamery from the Springfield Community Center every weekday during the program's eight weeks, beginning in early June through early August. All students enrolled at the Springfield Community Center for Summer School are eligible to participate.

The arts organizations and their instructors are selected because they are established and named organizations in the Springfield Regional Cultural Plan. Other teaching artists are also selected because they are outstanding and experienced artist in the community.

Many of the program's graduates participate in choir, band, dance, theater, and visual arts classes throughout their high school careers. Through written evaluations, graduates have attested that this program has given them a continued interest in appreciation for the arts and that the arts exposure given through this program has allowed them to feel more confident in the classroom.

- Served 47,708 people and 35 organizations via The Creamery Arts Center facilities
- Reduced overall expenses by more than \$20,000
- Increased Artsfest revenue by 27% from the previous year
- Raised \$8,285 and welcomed 100 new members surpassing the goal for the 3rd Annual SRAC Membership Drive at Mother's Brewing Company
- Hired four new staff members for the positions of Executive Director, Office Manager, Bookkeeper, and Facility Manager and created a new position for Membership Development
- Provided equipment and material transportation to 23 area arts organizations via the Arts Truck, which was driven nearly 3,000 miles
- Granted \$19,000 in Arts & Culture Grants to 16 area arts organizations to promote the arts, increase sustainability, and expand local arts programming
- Raised \$5,000 during fundraiser for Childhood in its Landscape program
- Completed Springfield Arts Collaborative Endowment Campaign
- Presented six Ozzie Awards at the 4th annual Flights of Fancy, the most celebrated collaborative arts gala of the year held at the Springfield-Branson National Airport
- Completed Creamery renovation projects including new flooring, new HVAC, and window replacement
- The Claymobile completed 16 visits
- Hosted SWMO regional competition for Poetry Out Loud with 12 competitors
- Hosted a lunch session for Leadership Springfield's Principals program
- Continued to grow partnerships with Springfield Public Schools
- Participated as a hosting partner for the 2nd Annual Summer Institute for Arts Integration
- Participated in a family education day at the Lighthouse Child and Family Development Center as part of Mini Monet outreach efforts
- Attended Any Given Child Exchange and expanded participation in Any Given Child Springfield initiative
- Hosted the legislative luncheon with more than a dozen local legislators, legislative staff, and City representatives
- Hosted 7th District Congressional Art Competition for Congressman Billy Long
- Enhanced partnership with Springfield Sister Cities Association with SRAC staff liaison on board of directors
- Attended the Americans for the Arts conference in Nashville, Tennessee
- SRAC Executive Director served as chair of Hotel/Motel Tax Allocation Committee
- SRAC staff served on grant evaluation panels for Missouri, Arkansas, and Oklahoma Arts Councils
- Hosted 3rd annual season of Speaking of the Arts
- Hosted the first live art/story collaboration with local artists and writers at Artsfest 2014
- Held American Watercolor Society show at Sky Gallery at the Springfield-Branson National Airport

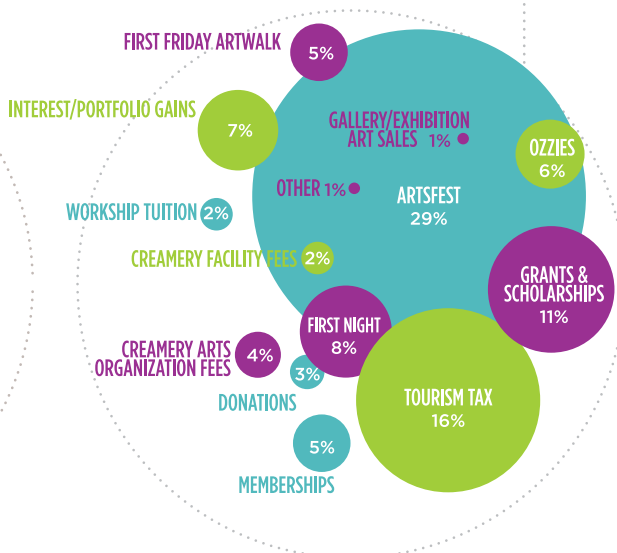
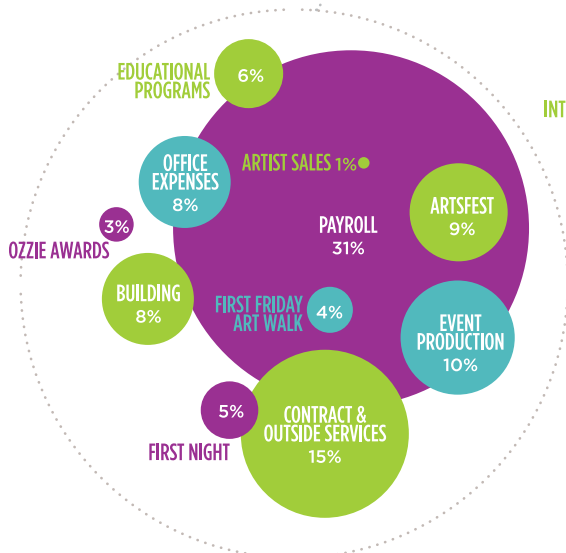
