NATURE RUBBINGS

MATERIALS

- ★ Paper
- ★ Crayon or Charcoal
- ★ Outdoors

- STEP 1** Hold your paper flat against a textured object. Try it with tree bark, rocks, leaves, sidewalks, a deck and more!
- STEP 2** Rub the side of your crayon or charcoal back and forth over the paper to catch the texture of the bark.
- STEP 3** Take photos of your new original artwork and tag any social media posts with **#SGFParks** and **#SpringfieldArts**

Did you know? Texture is surface quality that can be seen and felt. Textures can be rough or smooth, soft or hard. Textures do not always feel the way they look; for example, a drawing of a porcupine may look prickly, but if you touch the drawing, the paper is still smooth.
