## NATURE RUBBINGS

- MATERIALS**
- ★ Paper
  - ★ Crayon or Charcoal
  - ★ Outdoors

- STEP 1** Hold your paper flat against a textured object. Try it with tree bark, rocks, leaves, sidewalks, a deck and more!
- STEP 2** Rub the side of your crayon or charcoal back and forth over the paper to catch the texture of the bark.
- STEP 3** Take photos of your new original artwork and tag any social media posts with **#SGFParks** and **#SpringfieldArts**

**Did you know?** Texture is surface quality that can be seen and felt. Textures can be rough or smooth, soft or hard. Textures do not always feel the way they look; for example, a drawing of a porcupine may look prickly, but if you touch the drawing, the paper is still smooth.
