CHAIR RACK


Because the Creamery's 150year-old doors are too small for our current chair rack, we need shorter racks to move chairs easily throughout the building and have the option to load them onto the

OUTDOOR SIGN


Ideally, we'd have a custom marquee sign, but at minimum we need to update our

CORK WALL



DUNGEON CLEANUP


Our long-term storage is overflowing with rarely used items, we plan to overhaul it this winter with metal shelving, filing cabinet relocation,


SYMPHONY HALL GALLERY

COMMERCIAL FRIDGE


We currently have a tiny little baby fridge that doubles as a break room fridge. When events roll around it is difficult to
